

YOUR DAY: Each day at camp looks a little different, especially for our nurses, who will deal with various medical situations as they occur. You will be responsible for the administration and documentation of camper medications and treatments of campers & staff, maintaining all daily health lodge visit records using our electronic system. You will plan for and arrange appointments for any advanced medical treatment and will be responsible for determining when campers and staff need to see a doctor or go to the ER in an emergency/when to call 911. You will often liaise with parents in the case of campers sick enough to stay in the Health Lodge or when they require further treatment.

YOUR LIVING ARRANGEMENT: You will live in a private room in our Health Lodge.

YOUR PAY: \$1400/week (plus free camp for your kids!)

YOUR DATES: June 20 – August 17 (8-week, 2-week, 1-week, & per diem contracts available)

YOUR STRENGTHS: You are a caring and compassionate person who loves working with children and as part of a team. You are organized, mature, and show good judgemnet in a variety of situations. You are calm in a crisis and relate well to chidren, their parents, and to our college-aged staff.

REQUIREMENTS: Minimum 21 years old. **Licensed as an R.N. to practice in the State of CT.** Current CPR and First Aid. Preferred experience in pediatrics, emergency room or as a school nurse. Preferred experience as a nurse in a summer camp setting.
