

YOUR DAY: The counselor is responsible for managing the day-to-day safety and well-being of the campers in their care. Your primary job will be to guide the camp experience of the campers in your tent. Counselors also instruct activities within one of the program activity areas (or Day Camp). Whether in your role as a tent counselor or activity instructor, your primary concern is effective supervision of the children in your care and making sure every has FUN! You will work 6 days per week and will be on duty from approx 7:15am-10pm each day (sometimes later). During this time you will teach classes in your acvitity area, eat meals with your tent group, supervise campers during down-time, participate in free swim and help lead evening programs before putting your campers to bed. YOUR LIVING ARRANGEMENT: You will live in a platform tent with up to 7 campers. You may have a co-counselor in your tent. There are up to 7 tents in a Village and each Village has its own bathroom.

YOUR PAY: \$534/week plus completion bonus

YOUR DATES: June 5 - August 17/23 (dates dependent on role/certifications trainings)

YOUR STRENGTHS: Passion for working with children, enthusiasm, flexibility, compassion, leadership skills, the ability to think outside the box, an eye for safety, a love of the outdoors, a problem solving attitude, humor, inclusion.

REQUIREMENTS: Minimum of 18 years old, ideally with at least a year of college/work experience. Ability to instruct a variety of activities in your chosen program area. Prior camp/childcare experience preferred but not necessary. All staff must pass a background check.
