

YOUR DAY: As a member of the Advisory team, you are one of the most senior seasonal staff. You plan and deliver programs for campers aged 4–11 which are safe, age approprate and FUN. You work with your Program and Waterfront Directors to schedule campers activities and staff assignments. You are always present for Day Camp Drop off and Pick up each day, creating relationships with the parents at every opportunity. You spend your day checking in with your staff and campers, contacting parents, organizing schedule and group assignments, and working with other members of the Advisory and Director team to make everything run smoothly, making yourself available and providing assistance in overnight camp when your Day Camp responsibilities are complete.

YOUR LIVING ARRANGEMENT: You will live in a platform tent during Staff Orientation, then you will move to a staff cabin for the duration of the summer.
