



VILLAGE DIRECTOR

YOUR DAY: Village Directors are responsible for all village life programming (e.g. evening programs, structured downtime, Tent Bonding Time, Free Swim) and the safety and experience of all the campers and staff living in their Village (up to 50 kids). You will manage a team of 8-10 counselors, providing them with daily feedback and support. You will spend your day making sure each of your campers is having a positive experience, working together with the other Village Directors, as well as the Hill & Valley Camp Directors, to ensure Village life is running smoothly. You will communicate directly with camper parents, complete daily/weekly village paperwork, and be a resource for your staff when dealing with any problems that may arise. You will work 6 days per week and will be on duty from approx 7:00am-10pm each day (with potential for some later nights when designated as a Director on Duty).

YOUR LIVING ARRANGEMENT: You will live in the 'Head Tent', a platform tent in the village you oversee. You will live with 2 or 3 other Directors.

YOUR PAY: \$612/week plus completion bonus

YOUR DATES: May 31 - August 17

YOUR STRENGTHS: Passionate about working with children. You are a mature, organized, and creative problem solver, always thinking outside the box for how to make activities and events fun and engaging for campers and staff. You are caring and can create a safe and welcoming environment for people of all ages.

REQUIREMENTS: Minimum 21 years old. Previous experience of working as a camp counselor. Strong knowledge of child development and behavior management. Experience managing others or leading a team preferred. All staff must pass a background check.

WHY YOU MATTER: YOU CHANGE LIVES! The majority of the day at camp is spent in or with the village - you have the opportunity to create magical moments. You are a role model for the younger staff and for the campers - they will look to you for guidance and learning opportunities.
