#### DAY CAMP

Our Day Camp is BURSTING at the seams, with waitlists for all age groups in most sessions. We are now opening extra spaces across the summer AND adding Vacation Days in the last week of August, which will be available to sign up by the day for rising K-7th grades.

#### **OVERNIGHT CAMP**

Overnight camp is filling fast. We now have waitlists for Student Hill (rising 9th & 10th) in both Sessions 2 & 3, and in Junior Hill (rising 6th & 7th) Session 2. ### HAPPY ANNIVERSARY BEAR!

This past volunteer weekend marked the 18th anniversary of service to Sloane for our Executive Director/ CEO, Paul "Bear" Bryant. He says that he recalls his first volunteer weekend vividly – "it rained and was cold all weekend. There were less than fifteen of us putting up tents and I think we that we were only able to put up one or two villages (called sections back then) of tents – no cubbies, no bunks." Volunteer weekend has come a long way since then, often with over 100 people helping to erect every tent in camp, install every bunk and cubby and complete many other tasks which are necessary for getting camp open for the season. Camp has grown too. It was a \$1.4M operation back then and is budgeted to be a \$3.4M operation this year. He recalled that in his first summer we only needed nine tables in the boys' side of the dining hall to accommodate all the boys in the biggest session that summer. Today our day camp fills with nearly 130 participants each session and some sessions of sleep away camp have waiting lists and others are filling. During his tenure he has overseen over \$2M in program and facility improvements. Bear is the longest serving Executive Director/CEO of Camp Sloane YMCA. Happy anniversary Bear!
